

THE TRAIL THE WINES ACQUIRE

Alpha Omega, Crocker Starr, Gemstone, Newton, Rocca, Silver Oak, Spottswoode, Tamber Bey, Vineyard 29, Whitehall Lane—these great wineries have partnered to create the first cross winery Wine Collection in Napa Valley history, all to benefit the Napa Valley Vine Trail.



The Vine Trail Coalition was formed in 2008 to help design, construct and maintain a dedicated walking and biking trail through the entire Napa Valley. Over 25 miles are operating today or will be completed by 2021 with over 500,000 residents and visitors already using the trail each year to see the Napa Valley at a safer and more personal level. The Vine Trail Coalition board comprises 30 Napa Valley organizations spanning landowner, commercial, environmental, health, education, and civic members all with the single goal of bringing this generation

# spanning project to completion.

Each Vintner Collection winery is donating three barrels of wine to produce 900 Vine Trail Vintner Collections presented in a customer wooden holder in bottles that reveal a map of the Vine Trail from Calistoga to Vallejo. Each wine is a custom Cabernet Sauvignon blend and two wines will be released each year for the next five years. What's more, the bottles, corks, caps, labels, wine storage and wine shipping are being donated to the Vintner Collection to support the completion of the Vine Trail.

#### A TRAIL THROUGH THE WORLD'S MOST PERFECT TERROIR

Each of our program participants believe in the importance of creating a safe, paved, flat, car-free trail so our residents and visitors can enjoy Napa Valley up close and personal for years to come. The Vine Trail will pass more than 80 wineries and XX acres of vineyards as it winds north from the Vallejo Ferry Terminal, through American Canyon and Vista Carneros along the Napa River, across the City of Napa through the Rail Arts District and then northward next to the vineyards of Oak Knoll, Yountville, Oakville, Rutherford, Saint Helena and Calistoga.

#### YOUR CONTRIBUTION WILL BE MATCHED, THREE TIMES OVER

The Vintner Collection and wooden holder are priced at \$500 per bottle, \$400 of which is a charitable deduction to the Vine Trail. The money we will raise with this Collection will take the Vine Trail project funding from 66% to 100% funded and help us construct the whole trail by 2026. What's more, your contributions will be leveraged 3:1 with federal, state and local grants that your contributions will enable us to secure.
